### **Beekeeping notes for August:**

18<sup>th</sup> August: World Honey Bee Day – US initiative to raise awareness of Honey Bees and Hive products.

#### **August Forage:**

• Bees will be focusing on collecting pollen and nectar from summer flowering plants that include; Anise Hyssop, Bindweed, Cosmos, Hollyhock, Himalayan Balsam, Hebe, Ragwort, Rosebay Willow Herb, Sneezewort, Thistle to name a few! Identify the pollen source in your hives!

#### August tasks:

- If you haven't already, remove supers and extract the honey
- Monitor and treat the colony for Varroa (if Supers are on, non-chemical treatments)
- Ensure there is a strong, laying Queen and if not, now is the time to re-Queen
- Unite weaker or smaller colonies of bees
- Also, this is the month for Wasps and Hornets. If they are a problem, consider reducing the entrance space to the hives to help the bees protect their colony.

David Tyler is responsible for the ever-growing library and he brings the books to every meeting. All EBKA members can borrow the books – have a look and see what takes your fancy...!
